The Village of Sturtevant, an equal opportunity employer, is seeking a qualified person for the position of Department of Public Works Laborer and Equipment Operator. This is a full time position, with full benefits. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Operating various types of equipment such as backhoes, front end loaders, vacuum trucks, street sweepers, and dump trucks;
- Understanding the techniques, methods, materials, and equipment used in the maintenance and repair of streets, sewers, building, and grounds maintenance.

Additional requirements of the job:

- The position requires a valid State of Wisconsin CDL with a Class A, B and C with N endorsement CDL with no restriction for air brake operation.
- Successful candidate must live within 20 minutes drive time from the Village of Sturtevant.
